### **CARRY ON** - *All the necessities for your vacation, if checked in luggage ends up lost.*

*Kindly ask the flight attendants if there is somewhere that they can hang your wedding-day attire.*

- Passport and other IDs
- Credit cards, wallet, cash (for tipping)
- Medicine (in original bottle)
- Jewelry
- Cell Phones
- What you should have on your phone:  
Boarding Pass, Travel Documents,  
Transportation Confirmation E-mail,  
Travel Insurance Brochure, emergency  
contact info, contact for all vendors on  
location, copies of all contracts
- One swimsuit plus one outfit (so you can  
still go swimming/eat at the restaurants)
- Wedding day outfit (especially if bridal  
party)
- Camera, if separate from cell phone
- Head Phones / AirPods
- Sleeping Mask, Neck Pillow
- Book, Magazines, E-Reader/Tablet
- Flash drive with wedding music
- Groom's suit, shirt, tie, dress shoes,  
socks; Bride's dress, reception dress, veil,  
shoes, garter, jewelry, getting ready  
attire, special hangers, any other  
wedding-related accessories

### **CHECK IN BAG – WEDDING-RELATED**

- Special Outfits for wedding-related  
activities (rehearsal dinner, farewell  
brunch, etc.)
- Wedding night lingerie
- Extra lipstick/lipgloss for wedding photos  
(so your lips aren't chapped)
- Change of shoes for dancing
- Bridal Party Gifts (+ getting ready outfits)
- Groom's Gift
- Parent's Gift
- Wedding Favors
- Welcome bags and their contents
- Receipts of gifts/favors purchase (to  
show customs, just in case)
- Cake Topper, Signs, any additional décor  
you're bringing
- Guest book
- Ceremony (ring bearer pillow/box,  
flower girl basket, sand ceremony)
- Envelopes for payments and tips
- Wedding Planner Binder/Folder (copies  
of contracts, forms, etc.)
- Double-sided/fashion tape
- A copy of your invitation (for photos)

### **CHECK IN BAGS – VACATION-RELATED**

#### *Pool/Beach Necessities:*

- Swimsuits & Cover-Ups (1 per 1-2 days)
- Flip flops for the pool/beach
- Beach bag (some hotels include these)
- Sunglasses, sunhats

*Be sure to check dress code for restaurants.*

- Tanks, tees, tops
- Shorts, skirts, pants, bottoms
- Dresses, strapless bra
- Shoes for dinner/going out

- Sneakers/comfortable shoes for walking
- A wrap/sweater in case of chilly evenings
- Workout clothing
- Power bank
- Chargers for phone, watch, tablet, etc.
- Underwear, Socks, Bras, etc.
- Sleepwear
- Pro Tip: pack a tumbler with a reusable  
straw to keep your drinks cold and ditch  
the plastic!*

### **TO DO / LEAVE BEHIND BEFORE LEAVING:**

- Make copies of your passport, birth certificates, and all travel itineraries, and leave with someone at home and/or scan and email to yourself:
- Call your cell phone provider to inquire about adding an international package to your plan while you are abroad; some might be able to add this for free or for a small prorated fee if traveling to Mexico and the Caribbean. Otherwise, turn off the data on your phone and download WhatsApp, Viber, or another messaging app so that you can communicate with people via WiFi. Make sure the people you want to communicate with back at home or at the resort with you install the same app.
- Purchase Tourist Card/Visa, if necessary.
- Call your credit card companies and notify them of your travel plans. Ask them about foreign transaction fees and what logo to look for at ATMs to see if your card will work.
- Do a vacation hold on USPS.com
- Call your health insurance to find out what you need to do if you need medical/dental coverage while in a foreign country. Make copies of your prescription meds.
- Pay any bills that will become due while you're away.
- Clean out perishables from fridge. Place a Shipt/Instacart order or someone staying behind to get some groceries for you the day you're to arrive, so your fridge won't be empty when you come home.
- Turn off appliances/electronics; set thermostat.
